Just a word to thank you for your "petit mot:" it's always so nice to hear familiar voices... Gide's address is, 220 rue Michelet, Algiers, North Africa. Didn't I mention it before? Annet!! Should you be a little absent-minded? just a LITTLE bit??... I am afraid, however, that I don't know how to get hold of the issue of DECISION containing your article. What Gide knows of it is probably just the fragment, concerning his own person, incorporated in my book. -- As for Golo, his address is, First Experimental Detachment, APO 887, c/o Postmaster, New York. His letters sound cheerful enough, he seems to have a very interesting job in London. Unfortunately, I couldn't say the same thing of myself -- just now. But it is one of the good (if at times disturbing) qualities of army life that conditions change constantly and quickly. Having a pretty dull time right now, I may be destined to have all kinds of adventures and fine excitements tomorrow...

You didn't tell me anything about yourself. Are you working? What?

Seeing people? Whom? (I was kind of disappointed to hear that the Menasse who wrote the article is not the "right one"...)
