As for the "Private," it is -- as I pointed out before -- by no means a disgrace but a voluntarily made concession to the paper's long established policy. Besides I don't expect to remain in this status too long...Of course, I realize that it must be a l i t t l e embarrassing to have two "private" sons in the Army (or has Golo in the meantime made corporal?); but in organization like Sts.&Sts., or OSS, it really doesn't make much difference... I have just arrived here -- I am not supposed to disclose where -- and still am in the process of acclimatisation; but I have already begun to do some work, and before long may send you some samples of my new activity. The farewell from P.W.B. was rather sentimental; they all said they hated to see me go, and I suppose they actually didn't like it, but I kind of blackmailed them into it, as I insisted on either a commission or a release, while realizing that they were technically unable to give me the commission. Before leaving, I had another letter from you, and also one "Mimosa" which I have not acknowledged and thanked for as yet

(or have I?)... Already fully well, this was just to let you know about the transfer.
