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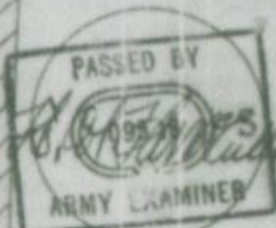

Italy, 27 January, 1945

MAMAN,

Just a word to tell you that yesterday -- just when I had mailed my letter complaining about the absence of packages -- a beautiful "Mimosa" arrived. But as I sent that last letter via Air Mail, this V-Mail note, including my warmest thanks, may reach you even before the complaint.

There is nothing new I could think of. I am waiting for my transfer -- and for the Russians to reach Berlin.

In your last few letters you have failed to mention either Moni or Muzi. Is the latter still alive? Is she going to live for ever? As for the former, I am in contact with quite a few of the people she used to know in Florence. It is surprising how popular she was in that city and how seriously people took her. That period when she met Lanyi, and entertained the German intelligentsia of Florence at the studio Pucci, was probably the happiest, most successful time of her life. Too sad.

Kitty Neumann sent me cigarettes and, moreover, a little box full of cigarette butts, most of them stained with lipstick -- which I thought exceedingly funny.
