New Organization of Europe, <sup>Finland, the men...</sup> bound to come, after present disasters.

The Other Germany has to get rid of Hitler; has to make peace with Allies.

Hitler doomed in any event.

Otherwise: Stalin really will win. His victory = the triumph of Chaos; civil wars; destruction...

Germans don't want this. Like Order.

Europe needs a New Order.

Federation.

Many problems involved; must be possible since it is <sup>much easier</sup> "New World": Halifax.

Not another Versailles. New Treaty essentially different. More peace (present Germany from re-arming); milder; (financial help. Avoid un-employment... <sup>Generalist</sup> "War?" - <sup>Y-m</sup> <sup>No.</sup>

Not changing of frontiers essential; but: depriving them of significance... <sup>too</sup> <sup>optimistic</sup> <sup>Worse</sup>: to <sup>get ready</sup> <sup>later</sup> <sup>Germany to be a vital part</sup> <sup>of that independent European organization</sup>



~~A new organization of Europe - :Germans have to realize that this has to come, later after the present war...:provided that the "Other Germany" is going to make Peace with England and France. Otherwise: ~~Stalins~~ Stalins victory - not Hitler's. He is doomed...Stalin would People understand, that, up to now, only Stalin was gaining..."Has won the war." Exaggerated - as Allies didn't lose it as yet...~~



And now, at this crucial hour, it is OUR duty to pronounce the great indictment - although our voices certainly are weaker than ~~the~~ Emile Zola's powerful word, and the ~~honors~~ moral scandal of the Breyfus trial was nothing, compared with the horrors we have to deal with... *German proper in the trial, now in exile, TA JK.*

It <sup>has</sup> become difficult, if not impossible, to defend the German people; to excuse what they have allowed their leaders to do... Dreadful documents, such as new British White Book, express the great "J'accuse" of civilized mankind.

<sup>And</sup> Yet, this horrifying document reports only minor parts of the awful truth... *The same internal government that has hosted citizens of own country - now responsible for catastrophe of WAR*

It is enough, the breaking-point is reached. The Other Germany has to awake. Decisive: Germans have to make their Revolution - the ~~the~~ First

Revolution of their long and tragic history - before the complete *debacle* military ~~defeat~~... *Germans may be defeated, but they must by foreign administration liberate themselves...*

There are indications...: unrest growing... Have to be careful and realistic. Wishful thinking must not <sup>influence</sup> change our judgement...

The other day, I was impressed and somehow shocked by an article in one of the liberal American Weeklies: "Is there Another Germany?" Question Remark... The guess of its author was: some older people in opposition; 95 percents of younger ones - men and women between 15 and 35 - : still for Hitler... *Dubious theory... within doubt will dubious into...*

Our informations are different.

New wanted was; *Munich Bomb*

ORIENTATION (September 27)

..... Far-Eastern Front (Pacific) - - seems in a state of preparation... Great events in the making, perhaps... But for the time being, spotlight on Europe - according to the principle: "Hitler first!"

Most significant: Russian Front.

Red Army surging toward Dnieper River...

Capture Smolensk & Kiev - key cities. Germans leaving Kiev like rats...

Nazi situation becomes increasingly desperate....

→ *Where intend German generals last stand?*  
Nothing to laugh in the Mediterranean theater, either.

Fall of Corsica and Sardinia (important: the part played by Free French and Italian natives...)

Allies approaching Naples - in flames; cut-off from outside world.... *Progress in Salerno sector*

Meanwhile, in Rome, Nazis "protect" the Vatican (grim irony!) - arresting cardinals....

Pathetic Mussolini continues the macabre farce of his puppet government, somewhere in Southern Germany or Northern Italy....

No wonder that Berlin is worried.... *Air Raids continue*  
Many possibilities for invasion, promised again by Churchill in recent address to the House of Commons.  
(Balkans, South of France, Holland etc.)

Facilitated by growing unrest in occupied countries...

(Yugoslaves fighting in Trieste; recent events in Denmark, etc)

Close collaboration between Great Britain/ U.S.A. - emphasized by appointment of General Marshall as global commander...

The same understanding not yet accomplished, alas, between Soviets, on the one hand - Anglo-Saxon democracies, on the other. Sinister rumors, caused by Stalin's absence from Quebec; resignation of Ambassador Litvinov, etc.

Comfort to the enemy, no doubt...

Maybe situation will be changed after meeting of Foreign Ministers in Moscow...

Other frictions:

Giraud/De Gaulle, over Corsica (speaking of France death of Edouard Herriot - serious loss...)

← Poland/Russia

MacArthur's resentful speech about Lord Mountbatten's appointment...

These things are about the only good news for the Germans...  
Question of German morale - more decisive than ever....
