"As you have reached the required age, you should immediately

to be burned. You should bring some firewood, coal and a container for
your ashes which will be used for the manufacture of soap. You should
close all pores and openings in your bodies ^{so} ~~hhhh~~ that your gases will
not poison employees of the Crematorium."

Now this ^{postcard} ~~my~~ ^{candidate} friends, ~~is~~ a joke. Not even Jews are
being cremated alive in today's Germany. But what a joke it is, what
sort of a mentality it reveals, and how horridly it fits and belongs.
~~Antisemitism~~ ^{Antisemitism}, far from having in the least subsided, has actually
increased, unimaginable though this ~~hh~~ may be. Hardly a day passes without
a Jewish grave yard, a synagogue being invaded, desecrated. Violently anti-
semitic ^{keep appearing} ~~articles~~ ^{along with posters shouting the obvious} ~~seriously~~ ^{veiled} in the German Press which
freed from the ^{at last} ~~fetters~~ ^{velvet} of allied licensing, is once again at liberty
to print whatever it pleases. 6 Million Jews have died. I have seen
many of the ~~hells~~ ^{and other indescribable horrors of Nazis} ~~hells~~ they died in. I've seen Auschwitz where

How did all this come to pass? ~~Why was it permitted to happen?~~ And ~~why is it allowed to continue even now,~~ when only a lunatic or a liar would care to deny that ~~extreme nationalism and neo nazism are rampant throughout Western Germany?~~

~~The chain of the tragedy embraces three leading characters~~
~~one of whom never appears on the stage, although his influence~~
~~decisively determines the~~
~~plot. His name is Hitler, the other two are called Goebbels and Hess.~~
~~Goebbels has always been a problem child whose many brilliant~~
~~gifts and characteristics~~ most of them
The Germans in the first place were never particularly eager to mend their ways. They never underwent an honest change of heart, and while, following the collapse, ~~most~~ ^{many} of them resented the Fuehrer's failure, only a ~~few~~ ^{counted} few - ~~He~~ would have minded his victory. Even so, they were stunned, confused, disorganized and quite ready to ~~obey~~ ^{obey} the laws laid down by the victors. No sooner, however, had they realized that the victors were fatally disunited, that they ~~disliked and feared each other~~ ^{utterly disliked and suspected each other} ~~and that~~ ^{in short} the very world constellation which had ~~helped~~ ^{facilitated} Hitler's conquest of Europe still existed, than they ~~hastened~~ ^{fully} to exploit the situation. ~~Why were they permitted to do so? Because -~~ ^{Of this no one would explain} nd there can be no doubt of it - because we consider fascism and neo Nazism a valiant ally in our struggle against communism which we hate and fear like the very devil.

Now provided even ~~hhh~~^{this} fear and hatred of ours were fully justified, ✓
would our alliance with fascism and Nazism appear to be reasonable?
It is my firm and irrevocable conviction that by aiding and abetting
fascism in Germany, ~~hhhhh~~ and by re-building the power of a people
whose rank and file defeat has taught no lesson but whose ~~greed~~^{arrogance} and
it has quickened rather than mitigated, the U.S. is making a grave mistake,
surely ~~one~~^{perhaps} of the gravest ~~hh~~^{of} her short and glorious history. By no means
and not under any circumstances will this kind of G. live to be
a reliable ally of ours. Nor shall we find it easy to prevent
Europe's biggest, most dynamic and by far her most aggressive people
from menacing and eventually dominating ~~hh~~^{their} ~~hh~~^{once to the} neighbours, ~~our true~~^{under!}
~~allies~~^{granted to}. Besides - and how easy it is to be a prophet in this alarming
context - besides there'll always be dangling over our heads the threat
of a German ~~hhhhh~~^{Soviet} alliance, and whenever a new German demand, a new
German move may cause us to sound a warning, ~~the~~^{our} G.s need merely smile;
they'll smile at Russia whereupon we shall hastily bow to their will.
More: we shall invite our Western European dependents also to bow to
Germany's will, and indications are that they'll ~~accept~~^{be made to} ~~our~~^{get such} invitation.
Even today France and the Benelux countries have had to stomach many
a crucial concession we saw fit to make to ~~Germany~~^{the new} and which our
friends, rightly, I think, consider detrimental to their security. But then,
there is always Russia; and always there is that irrational tendency of
ours to deem anything and if need be even a German dominated Europe
a healthy expedient in the face of the red menace. Just how healthy and
how expedient we should find a German Europe we have no need to guess.
We have just been through it all, and we know.

In running the occupation, and gradually turning the ~~administration~~ ^{re} administration
zone to ~~the administration~~ ^a Germans, the Soviets
have primarily worked and relied upon persons manifestly friendly toward
them, while simultaneously attempting (^{no matter how} never mind how successfully)
to ~~convert~~ convert the bulk of the population through education,
inducements, and force. All that the Russians do regarding the Eastern
German republic, is in accordance with their principles and clearly
and neatly
designed to serve their purposes both in general and in particular.
In short, the soviet zone makes sense - soviet sense, which is precisely
what it ought to make.

The Bonn state on the other hand makes no sense whatsoever.
~~The area has not been demilitarized~~
In running the occupation, delegating power and gradually returning
the area to a German administration, we have not primarily worked with
and relied upon people of known loyalty to our cause; ~~quite the con-~~
trary: ~~the very individual,~~ ^{influence} the very individual,
cliques and circles responsible for world war II, and whose ~~power~~ ^{was} was
to be broken once and for all, have been restored to power. Europe's
industrial heart, the Ruhr, is once again owned and operated by ^{the} small
bunch of ~~supermen~~ ^{highly decorated war lords} every one of whom should have been tried for war crimes
and crimes against humanity. The Bonn Parliament is infested with Nazis
and Nazi sympathizers, and while unlike the Russians we've ~~given~~ made it
a point to give the Germans more and more freedom, this freedom is being
abused - under our very eyes - ^{for the purpose - not of destroying} not to destroy democracy (for there is
none) but ^{of} to forestall ^{its} the establishment of anything resembling democracy.
But then, - you'll rightly say - democracy can't be enforced whereas communism
can. And if the Germans didn't want to become democrats, ~~how could we~~
have ^{we couldn't have forced them}

~~we couldn't have changed their minds for them. No, we couldn't.~~
~~at least 40,000, ourselves~~ *formed our democratic goals*
But - ~~like the Russians~~ - we could have ~~acted according to~~
~~convictions and~~
our avowed principles. We could have looked for the better G. elements,
~~for the true antinazis and liberal democrats;~~
by encouraging and strengthening these scattered forces we should have
gradually
increased ~~the~~ and solidified their authority ~~with the~~
~~thus building up a democratic machinery comparable with the~~
communist *and eventually as for its reliability*
~~machinery operating in the soviet zone. In order to do this,~~
we would have had to use force only ~~according~~
to the ~~decrees valid under M.G.~~ ^{MG} Law No. 154 in parti-
cular and control council law No. 8 would have gone far in preventing
the re-nazification and re-militarisation of Western Germany. *Scarcely*
We just
don't seem to like our own laws. ~~Nor do we~~
seem to like those we like - or ^{used to} liked - us. We prefer people who are known
to hate us, who say that they hate us but - and here we return to the
crux of the matter - who also say that they hate the Russians better.
That
~~if~~ these people have lied before ^{apparently} doesn't ~~disturb us~~ much.
Remember Mr. Chamberlain ^{and} the day he came back from Godesberg ^{here} Hitler, he
reported ^{he rely} wanted to liberate his Sudeten brethren; in fact, ^{he just} he had
promised that this - the Sudetenland - constituted his last territorial
claim. When reminded that ^{Chamberlain H.} ~~der Fuhrer~~ had repeatedly made and broken
such promises, good old Neville replied haughtily: that was ^{rather} different
^{for} because this time he promised me.

We are, my friends, on the wrong road, - a wretched old dirt road congested to boot by past failures. ^{on so discredited a track? then why?} Why continue on ~~such~~ it? Why not follow the best, the finest A. tradition, - look for the wide open spaces, try something new, bold and promising. ² What are we afraid of? ² Whether or not you liked him and all or any of his policies, he was a great American President who said: The only thing we have to fear is fear itself.
