As for Lord Dawson and Mr. ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ (late editor in chief of the London Times), Dr. Sauter, who had barely heard of the above named, regretted that his client had proved so ill informed.

"All of this was his idea", said Ribbentrop's counsel despondently.

He may yet claim a number of ~~high~~ high Soviet officials with whom, he asserts, he drafted the Russo-German pact of August 1939. According to Ribbentrop, the pact contained secret clauses which have never been disclosed. He says that their publication at this moment might be most opportune. As far as Dr. Sauter knew, his client had not made up his mind about the desirability of inviting Russian witnesses. <sup>after today's adjournment</sup> ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ "I haven't seen him ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~, said Sauter.
