My dear Prime Minister.

The undersigned wish emphatically to join in the protest voiced by all those who - owing to Professor Grzimek's TV-reporting - are appalled by the unhuman treatment suffered each year by many hundreds of thousands of baby seals in your country. We are aware of the fact that your government have attempted to stop the skinning alive of those lovable and helpless young animals but we also know that your endeavour has not thus far produced the desired effect.

We therefore most respectfully suggest that stronger measures be taken and that any skinning alive of seals should be declared a crime (to be severely) punished. Please rest assured that any drastic step on your part in this direction will be keenly appreciated throughout the world, just as the continuation of the detestable practice sketched above cannot but continue to cast a shadow over a country otherwise so generally liked and admired as Canada.
