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Gentlemen.

I have just written to Mrs. Arnold Schönberg asking her permission to include a very limited number of Thomas Mann's letters to Schönberg in my second volume of collected letters by Thomas Mann. As you are in the physical possession of the letters, there can be no doubt that I should need your authorization as well.

As I mentioned to Mrs. Schönberg, there might be a day when either she or yourself desire to publish - wholly or in part - the correspondence between Schönberg and my father in which case it would be up to us to grant you the copyright. At any rate, however, a few ~~of~~ Thomas Mann-letters to Schönberg reproduced in a large volume of collected letters could certainly not lessen the value of your collection. On the contrary, it might wet the appetites of rather a greater number of people than might normally be attracted by the very special genius of Schönberg.

In order to obtain the best possible selection and in the interest of balance and composition, I should be very grateful, if you'd let me have photostats of all the T.M.-letters to Schönberg at your disposal. The photostats should be addressed to me whereas the bill would have to go to
