This is to accuse myself - and other ^{frightened} friends
~~and admirers~~ of the United States - of a grave
crime of omission. ^{As soon as} ~~once~~ a retrial of Jack Ruby had
become thinkable, one crucial question should have
been raised in public: - unless he got himself shot
in front of TV cameras, what ^{swiftly} fatal disease was to
^{eliminate stunts} ~~put an end to~~ Mr. Ruby's ~~sturdy~~ life? Raised
promptly and in public, this question might not
only have saved Ruby's life; it might also have
saved those in charge from committing an error of
judgment which can only serve to undermine still
further American prestige abroad. Instead of a
mere "credibility gap", there is now a yawning
gulf. Ruby is ^{dead} ~~dying~~, and I for one feel guilty.
